- Entries must be set out on the appropriate entry form and accompanied by the entry fee.
- No late entries will be accepted.
- No refund of entry fees will be made.

Judging

- All decisions of the judge/s will be final.
- All exhibitors are requested to refrain from conversing with the judge/s during judging unless asked to do so.

Entry to the Showground

Exhibitors wishing to enter the showground during the running of the show will pay normal gate prices unless otherwise specified in this Schedule, or if the exhibitor is a member of the Association.

Vehicular access is permitted in the lead-up and following the Show, for the delivery and collection of your exhibit. Vehicular access is permitted for animal exhibitors only during the Show.

ENTRY FEE: \$1

ENTRIES CLOSE: 9th March 2012

This section to be run under the by-laws and Regulations of the Newcastle A.H. & I. Association.

All care will be taken with exhibits but the Association does not accept responsibility for theft, damage or breakage. Plants will be watered as required.

STAGING: Entries to be staged between the hours of **5pm and 8pm on Thursday 15th March 2012.** Exhibits not staged by the time stated will not be accepted. Exhibits are to be brought to the Exhibition Centre (Hall of Industry). Judging will take place on **Friday 16th March 2012 at 11am.**

COLLECTION: Exhibits to be collected on **Sunday 18th March 2012,** between the hours of 5pm and 6pm or on Monday morning, 19th March, between 8am and 10am.

Except where indicated, embellishments will be allowed in all Floral Art Exhibits, including painted natural materials. No artificial plant parts allowed. All care, but no responsibility taken for the loss or damage to containers or embellishments.

GRADINGS CLASSIFICATIONS:

OPEN: open to florists and any other

A GRADE: for exhibitors who are professionals or those who are graded "A" by any Horticulture Society.

B GRADE: for exhibitors who are not employed professionally in floral work, or paid to do floral work.

Note: B Grade Exhibitors need to win three Championships before they are classed as "A" Grade.

PRIZE MONEY: as stated.

RIBBONS: 2nd Place Ribbons will be awarded in the Junior Classes.

PRIZE CARDS: Will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Places.

MEDALLIONS: Awarded where stated.

AWARDS:

The Grand Champion of the Show and the **Reserve Champion of the Show** will be awarded a Rosette and will both receive a \$10 prize awarded by the Newcastle Regional Show.
