#### **CONDITIONS:**

1. Open to all High Schools and Primary Schools.
2. Each team member must be a student of the School they represent.
3. Each team member will be judged individually and the team's total points will decide the Winner, Runner-up and Third place. **A student should not be entered separately as an individual and as a team member.**
4. One team member only will represent the team in the orals.

#### **HIGH SCHOOL PRIZES:**

*The WINNING TEAM* will receive the Newcastle Regional Show High School Beef Cattle Judging Perpetual Trophy, a memento trophy for the school, a sash for each team member, and a cheque for \$200 to purchase equipment for their school.

*The RUNNER-UP TEAM* will receive a sash for each team member and a cheque for \$75 to purchase equipment for their school.

**RIBBONS:** Will be presented to each member of the winning team, runner-up team and third place getters. Ribbons are to be retained by the team members.

#### **PRIMARY SCHOOL PRIZES:**

The WINNING TEAM will receive the Newcastle Regional Show Primary School Beef Cattle Junior Judging Competition Perpetual Trophy, a memento trophy and a cheque for \$100 to purchase equipment for their school.

*The RUNNER-UP TEAM* will receive a cheque for \$75 to purchase equipment for their school.

**RIBBONS:** Will be presented to each member of the winning team, runner-up team and third place getters. Ribbons are to be retained by the team members.

#### **INDIVIDUAL POINT SCORE COMPETITION**

Open to all students of schools (Primary and Secondary) up to year 12, and will run in conjunction with the above competitions. There will be an individual winner in both High School and Primary School sections.

The individual point score of students entered in the above Teams events will count in the judging of this competition.

The individual competitor with the highest point score in the **HIGH SCHOOL** section and **PRIMARY SCHOOL** section will each receive a commemorative plaque, trophy (watch) and sash. Sashes will also be presented to the runner-up and third place getters. *Individual* Students may be required to do an oral test.

**Entry Details:** Entry Forms along with the appropriate Entry Fee are to be returned to Newcastle A H & I Association by **16<sup>TH</sup> March 2010. No late entries accepted.** On receipt of Entry form and Entry fees by the Show Association, a letter will be sent to the teacher listed on the form, enclosing gate entry passes for students nominated and teacher, to allow entry to the grounds. (One Teacher in Charge will be admitted free with each team).
