DETAILS OF ENTRY

The MINI GARDEN Competition encourages children as a class or school to have fun in creating their own "Mini Garden" and be in the running to win fabulous prizes for their school. Let their imagination's run wild. Three categories - to suit Kindergarten to Year 6. Judging is based on criteria such as design, creativity and originality.

Prizes:

Winning school in each category to receive a cash prize of \$75.00 and a commemorative plaque will be presented to the school, with the runner up receiving a \$25.00 cash prize. Winning School in each Section will receive a Hunter Valley Gardens Excursion for 30 students. Winning School in the Fragrant Garden Section will receive the special prize of a Compost Bin, donated by Newcastle Council Community Greening Centre.

Special Prizes: Additional great prizes have been donated from the donors listed below and will be awarded at the time of Judging. All prizes will be mailed out after the Show.

Conditions:

All Mini gardens are to be no larger than 600mm x 600mm in size. They can consist of any medium and they must have a solid base. Mini Gardens will be displayed in the Exhibition Centre (Hall of Industry). Each group entering may only enter once. Exhibits will be watered as required and all care taken, but no responsibility will be accepted for any damage that may be caused to plants.

Delivery:

To the Horticulture Section in the Exhibition Centre at Newcastle Showground, on Thursday March 25th between 12pm and 5pm. Judging will take place on Friday 26th.

Collection:

Exhibits must be collected between the hours of 9 am – 12 noon on Monday 29th March 2010 from the Exhibition Centre. Please note that we have no way to store these gardens after Monday 29th.

Entry forms should be mailed or faxed to the Show Office by **Thursday, 18th March 2010**, 5 pm.

Please take a copy of the entry form and attach it to your garden when you bring it in.

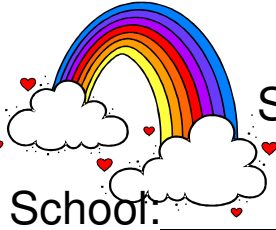
