Entry to the Showground:

Exhibitors wishing to enter the showground during show hours, will pay normal gate prices, unless otherwise specified in this Schedule.

Access is permitted on Sunday from 4pm to collect your exhibits. You must produce your collection ticket/receipt upon entry to the Showgrounds to collect exhibits. Please collect exhibits by 5pm Sunday.

Please note: There is no vehicle access during the show period Friday 1-Sunday 3 March 2019.

MEMBERSHIP OF THE ASSOCIATION

N.A.H.& I. Association is a not for profit, community based organisation. Membership runs from 1 July to 30 June. Standard member fees are Adult \$25 and Junior \$20.

ENTRY /EXHIBIT REQUIREMENTS:

- Entry Fee to all classes is \$3
- Exhibitors are only permitted to enter one (1) entry per Class
- Classes must be presented for Judging in a standard 500g/375ml clean round glass jar, with a white 63mm plastic or white metal lid. (Not tamper proof) *Three jars are required per exhibit.*
- Labels to be on the lid of your exhibit. *Labels will be available upon delivery of your exhibits for you to affix to the lid of your exhibits. Please make sure you know which class these exhibits are being entered in. For postal entries, labels will be posted to you approx. 2-3 weeks prior to the show for you to affix.*
- All Exhibits must be of Australian Origin, 100% Australian honey and apiary products, produced and packaged in Australia.
- Exhibits must be the bona fide production of the Exhibitor's Apiary.
- All exhibits must have been produced in the past twelve months.
- Exhibits that fail to meet the requirements of any Class will not be placed on display or judged.

OPEN CLASSES:

- Any Exhibitor can enter these Classes and there is no minimum or maximum number of colonies required.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Friday 15th February 2019. 5 pm Late Applications after this time and date will not be accepted.

HOW TO ENTER: Please see previous page:

DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS: Thursday evening, 28 February 2019. TIME: Between 5 pm – 6 pm

Exhibits only accepted during these times, unless received by post.

LOCATION FOR DELIVERY: Agricultural marquee, Newcastle Showgrounds. Grassed area near Woodturners building. Access by vehicle via the Griffiths Road, Broadmeadow entry, or by foot via Curley Road entry.

COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS: Sunday March 3, 2019- Agricultural Marquee. TIME: Between 4 pm – 5 pm

Please bring your ticket/receipt for collection of exhibits. You may also be asked to produce receipt at the Show entry gates.

Note: Unless otherwise instructed by the Exhibitor, Exhibits not collected on Sunday 3 March by 5pm, will be held at the show office until the following day only. Exhibits not collected by 4pm on the Monday 4 March, will then become the property of the Newcastle A. H. & I. Association Inc.

JUDGING: Judging will take place on Friday morning before 9am. All Judging is closed to Exhibitors and the general public. Judging is to be conducted as per Colour Pfund reading and Scale of Points as below.

AWARDS/PRIZEMONEY: All Classes: 1st will receive \$15, 2nd \$10 and 3rd \$5 plus ribbons and prize cards.

Champion Liquid Honey will receive a Ribbon, Rosette and Prize card.

Best Exhibit in Show – \$100 cash plus Ribbon and Rosette.
